



Data sheet	Monoclonal antibody to human interferon gamma (IFN- $\gamma$ ) Biotin-labeled

Clone:	MD-1
Isotype:	Mouse IgG <sub>1</sub>
Production:	<i>In vitro</i> using serum free medium.
Purification:	Ion exchange chromatography.
Labeling:	With Biotin-7-NHS (N-hydroxysuccinimide).
Packaging:	Lyophilized and vacuum-packed.
Contents:	0.5 mg/vial
Buffer:	Prior to lyophilization: 0.5 ml PBS + 125 mM trehalose.
Specificity:	Neutralizes both natural and recombinant human IFN- $\gamma$ <i>in vitro</i> . The antibody shows high cross-reactivity with rhesus macaque IFN- $\gamma$ but exerts no reactivity towards mouse and rat IFN- $\gamma$ and human IFN- $\alpha$ and - $\beta$ .
Sterility:	Membrane filtered (0.2 $\mu$ m).
Reconstitution:	Dissolve the contents of the vial by injection of 0.5 ml sterile distilled water.
Stability:	Lyophilized product is stable for at least one year at 4°C (expiry date is indicated on the vial). After reconstitution, the contents can be safely stored at 4°C for one month or for one year at -20°C. Add 0.02% sodiumazide to prevent bacterial growth.
Quantitation:	Antibody concentration was determined by absorbance, taking A280=1.4 for a 1 mg/ml solution.
Application:	Detection antibody in ELISA systems Intracellular staining
